

118th United States Congress: At A Glance

The United States Congress is composed of the United States Senate and the United States House of Representatives. Congress is the legislative branch of the federal government.

The 117th Congress convened in Washington, D.C., on January 3, 2023 and will end on January 3, 2025.

The Senate has 100 seats. Each state has 2 senators. The Democrats hold a 51 seat majority (48 Democrats and two independents who caucus with Democrats) while Republicans hold 49 seats.

The House of Representatives has 435 seats. The number of representatives per state is determined by that state's population and is determined every 10 years by the Census. Republicans hold a majority in the House with 222 seats. Democrats have 212 seats. As of January 7, 2023, there is one vacancy in the House.
